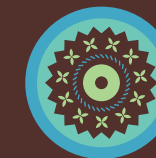

Our Goal

By working together and connecting through Hui and Fono, the goal of this work is to develop a **network of community providers, researchers and health systems representatives** that can help facilitate the **implementation of novel programmes, interventions and products** that help to meet the **health needs of Māori and Pacific communities**.

The Network

The network will be:

- + **Community provider** focused
- + A network with **specific areas of focus** for **Māori**, and for **Pacific communities**
- + Focus on **common interests and philosophies**
- + Guided by the following **principles**:
Indigenous mātauranga, Pacific approaches, frameworks and cultural practices, co-design and mutual respect, options and self-determination, health equity, bi-directional learning and dialogue, and sustainability.

Future Development

Development will occur through a **co-design process** with **input from members**.

There are **different levels of involvement** in the network:

1. Just being informed of outputs;
2. **Active trialing of outputs** including an **adaptation process** to fit their communities and
3. **Identifying additional** research needs or needs for additional programmes.
